

WHO ARE PRISONERS?

A **prisoner**, also known as an **inmate**, is anyone who is deprived of liberty against their will. This can be by confinement, captivity, or by forcible restraint.

2 types of Prisoners exist:

Lawfully confined:- Those charged with crime or civil liability

Unlawfully imprisoned:- Those not detained by virtue of some lawful, judicial, legislative or other proceeding. They are entitled on the immediate discharge on Habeas Corpus

Criminals are persons convicted for a crime

Criminal Justice: the entire procedure of bringing a criminal to justice; from investigation through arrest, charges, trials, sentences and punishment.



CLASSIFICATION OF PRISONERS

Inmates are classified to ensure they are placed in a correctional setting that most appropriately addresses their programming and custodial needs.

- Female prisoners
- Convicted
- Youthful prisoners (juveniles)
- Old aged prisoners
- Civil prisoners
- Prisoners affected by contagious diseases
- Escapees and hardcore criminals
