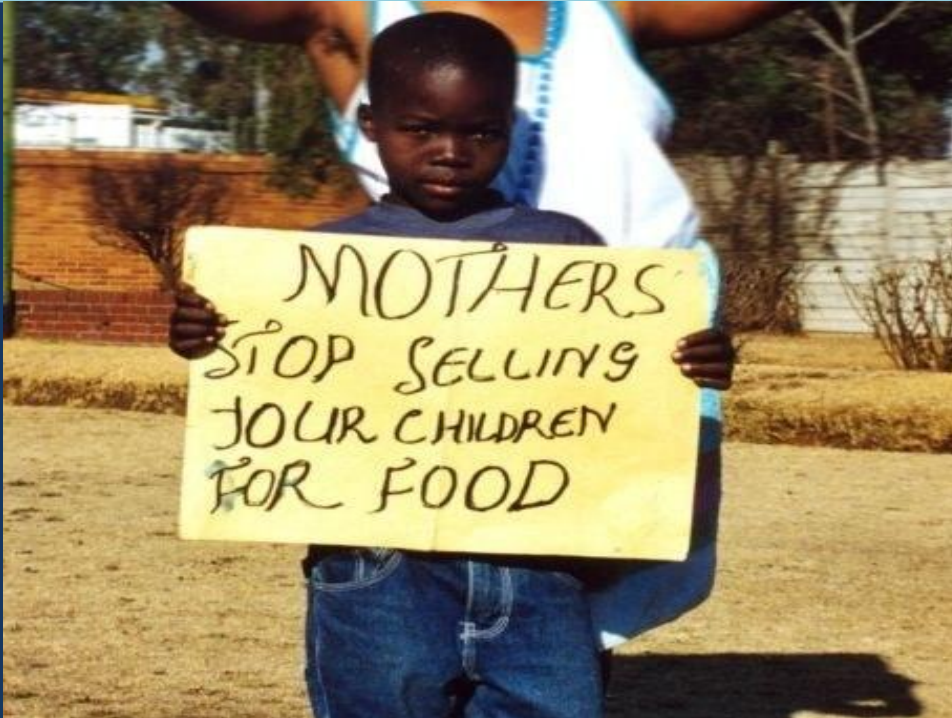

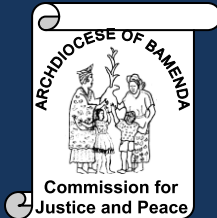


Prevent Human Trafficking!
